Conditions Of Entry

The General Regulations of the Wangaratta Agricultural Society Inc appearing on this schedule form part of these AAA approved conditions of entry. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these conditions, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations Provide otherwise. This Show will be conducted under the Rules of the Australian Alpaca Association as set out in the current AAA Showing Rules Manual. (All exhibitors should familiarise themselves with the current AAA inc showing rules & guidelines & Central Region Showing Protocol.)

All exhibitors should read the conditions (1-4) on the entry form and ensure that they can comply with those conditions before signing the entry form, particularly noting the condition dealing with animal health. A separate health declaration form is provided for signature and return with the entry form. Failure to sign the entry form will render all alpacas of an exhibitor ineligible to be exhibited. Please note that the registered owner of an exhibit, or, his/her authorised agent may sign an entry form. The registered owner of an exhibit in the case of an entire animal must be a financial member of the AAA. It is not a requirement for exhibitors of wethers to be financial members of the AAA.

Alpacas travelling interstate must comply with State's Department of Industry requirements.

Period Of Exhibition

Alpacas must be penned by 8:30am Sat 8th Oct and may not be removed from the Show Grounds until 4pm Sat 8th Oct

The Convenor is the only person authorised to approve early departure. Any requests for special consideration should be referred to Glenn & Shirley Hurley

Alpacas can be penned between 4pm – 9pm Fri 7 Oct & 7am – 8:30 am Sat 8th Oct.

Exhibitors Meeting

There will be no exhibitors meeting. Any changes to the program will be announced by the MC

Judging

Judging will commence at 10am 8th Oct . The judge's decision is final. He/she may choose not to award a prize or prizes in a class.

All attendants in the judging ring must wear white coats, with clean dress shoes or boots. The chief steward may disqualify anyone for incorrect attire.

Exhibitors must display the exhibitor card with the age in months clearly displayed on the card.

Preparation of Exhibits and Cleanliness Of Stalls

Exhibitors must keep the stalls allocated to their animals clean, and give proper attention to their stock throughout the show. Exhibitors must provide their own feed, feed and water containers. Exhibitors are required to dismantle pens before departure.

Advertising

No advertising or notices (except with the permission of the Chief Steward) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings. Sale signs are not permitted. Stud names are permitted but must be contained to the bounds of the pen and to height of 1500 mm. Display of Show Ribbons at a show held at another venue is prohibited.

A handler will be deemed to be inappropriately attired if his/her dress or the animal being led displays any information capable of being construed as advertising for any stud.

Companion Animals

Special permission to bring a companion alpaca must be obtained from the Convenor or Chief Steward prior to submitting the entry form, otherwise no companion animal will be permitted.

Inspection Of Exhibits

All alpacas must be registered with the Australian Alpaca Association Inc and carry an approved brass tag showing the alpaca's IAR number. A copy of the pedigree certificate of each alpaca entered (both sides) must accompany the entry form. Wethers may be registered or unregistered alpaca.

Inspection of alpacas will commence at 8am Sat 8th Oct.

Alpacas not in their allocated pens and available for inspection at the official time may be disqualified by the chief steward. Exhibitors must be in attendance at the time of inspection and are required to assist.

The Inspector or Chief Steward will classify all entries for age, sex and colour and has the power to transfer an exhibit to the class which, in his/ her opinion it should have been entered. The Chief Steward will combine or split classes as he/she sees fit.

Huacaya must carry a minimum fleece length of 50mm and a recommended maximum length not exceeding 130 mm. The minimum fleece length for Suri's is 75mm and fleece length will be assessed by the judge.

Exhibits shall not have fleece of a different colour to that of the blanket removed from an animal to a level below that of the blanket fleece.

Any alpaca found to have lice infestation must be removed from the showgrounds immediately along with any other alpacas present that belong to the same exhibitor

Protests: All protests are to be referred to the Chief Steward or Convenor in accordance with the AAA inc. Show Guidelines. Only an exhibitor may lodge a protest.

Entry Fees

In order to exhibit alpacas at the Wangaratta Show, Patrons Tickets are to be purchased prior to first day @ \$36 (2 days)

Patrons:	\$36
Alpaca Entries:	\$15
Fleece Entries:	\$10

Exhibitors showing fleeces only do not have to become Patrons of the Society, however fleece entries, for non Patron is \$15 per fleece.

Huacaya Sections and Class Numbers

Note: Huacaya 12 months and older must be shorn regularly so that no more than 15 months fleece is carried at the time of showing.

Huacaya Junior Ages Classes Sections 1 & 2 may be split in two if there are 15 or more entries in any one

colour class. That division becomes: 6 to under 9 months, and 9 to under 12 months.
