All exhibitors must sign a *Johnes Disease Declaration Form* - enclosed. Cattle Exhibits are also requested not to leave the ground before 3.30pm otherwise Prize Money will be forfeited.

If in the opinion of the Stewards, any animal is considered unsafe, such animal shall be placed under such control as directed by Stewards. Animals to be secured by halter and neck rope. Exhibitors are requested to provide own feed troughs. Society to provide straw.

Cattle can enter showgrounds after 4pm on Friday.

Beef Section

Beef Breeds are to exhibit on Saturday, October 8, 2011. Judging to commence at 9.30 am. Exhibitor to provide name of animal and date of birth of each exhibit with entry form.

Exhibitors declare that Exhibits in the Cattle Section are the property of the Exhibitors, and are entered subject to the Rules, Regulations and Conditions of the Society.

All Bulls in this Section D, 12 months old or over, must be rung through the nose and at all times shall be led by such ring. All females to be led with a nose clip.

An animal shall not be admitted to the judging ring during the judging of any class unless it is an exhibit in such class, but a calf of the exhibit in a beef breed class may be admitted if it is under the age of eight months and is being suckled by the exhibit.

Dairy Section

Unless otherwise specified no cattle can be entered in the yearling class if calved before July 1, 2010, in the two-year-old class if calved before July 1, 2009, in the three-year-old class if calved before July 1, 2008. All in-milk classes to be judged first, and on completion the Champion Dairy Cow will be judged. Dairy Breeds will be judged on Saturday only, judging to commence at 9.00 am.

All Cattle Must be NLIS Tagged . All Electrical Leads Must be Checked and Tagged before use at the Show.
