6. Each garment entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
7. If, for any reason, a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final level, then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.

An exhibit may only win one Group Final in a show season, should the same article be entered again and found to have already won a Group Final in the same Show season the exhibitor must return the prize money and will be disqualified from exhibiting for 12 months.
3. The Melbourne Group 14 winner of the current Show will compete as a finalist in the following State Final at the Royal Melbourne Show.
4. A garment/outfit having won at a Show will compete at a Group Final; the winning garment/outfit will then compete at the State Final at the next Royal Melbourne Show.
5. A garment/outfit having won at State Final is no longer eligible to compete in the competition.
6. Each garment entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
7. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final Level then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.
