

Horse Exhibitors and Competitors Information

Camping: Charges for ALL type of camping: \$10 per night to cover power, etc. payable when ordering stables.

Stables: Lock up boxes \$30, Lock up stalls \$15, Open stalls \$10.

Owing to the limited Lock Up \$30 Horse Boxes, our Society cannot guarantee any lock up accommodation, therefore you enter on the understanding that you arrange for your own care of your horse if necessary. It is essential for Competitors to complete the '**Tear Out Slip**' in the back of the Schedule and forward with full payment before any consideration can be given for Boxes.

Entry Fees: Post Entries Taken on Day of Show

Entry to All Ridden and Led Horse Events Will Be by Ticket or \$2 coin to ring steward. Tickets will be on sale each Show Day, 7.30am Ticket Booth in the center of the Horse Saddling Area (adjacent to the measuring stand) at Horse Superintendent's Office. All Jumping classes as per schedule includes V.A.S.L. Insurance. No refund of unused tickets.

Tickets must be handed to the steward in charge prior to entering each event.

All Exhibitors shall pay at the Gate.

Waivers: (found in back of Schedule)

Must be signed and handed in at horse office when a wristband will be issued and must be worn throughout the show.

Exhibitors Please Note:

A Competitor must choose to enter in classes as either a Show Hunter or a Show Horse, but not enter both. Once a horse has competed as a Show Horse or a Show Hunter at its first VAS event in a calendar year it must remain as a Show Horse or a Show Hunter at VAS competitions for that calendar year.

Once a horse has successfully won a champion in its first ring it cannot continue to compete in that equivalent section in other rings during the show.

First place getters are eligible to compete in multiple rings until successful as champion.

Please read the Schedule carefully prior to making your entries, as the Rules, Regulations and Conditions of each class shall be strictly adhered to. If you are in doubt, please ask.

Exhibitors are strongly advised that they must be in attendance to ensure inclusion in event. Please follow the program. Under No Circumstances will an event be held up waiting for a competitor who may be in another ring or waiting for a mount from another ring.

All Dogs must be tied up or securely locked away throughout the period of the Show. Should any dogs be found wandering loose on the Showground's, they will be impounded by the City Pound Keeper.

At commencement of the Fireworks Display at 8.30 **all horses** must be securely locked away in stables.

Strictly no camping or horses allowed on the ground prior to 5pm Thursday 6th October 2022

Horses may be tied to floats or trucks in the outside car park.

Exhibitors declare that exhibits in Horse Section are the property of the Exhibitor and are entered subject to the Rules, Regulations and Conditions of the Society.

Where height is stipulated the Official Measurer, who will be in attendance from 8.00am, must measure all Ponies, Galloway's or Horses each day of the Show. The height certificate must be produced to the Stewards when entering the ring for judging (half inch shall be allowed for shoes). Melbourne Show Certificates and E.F.A. Certificates will be accepted.

Stallions are only eligible to compete in their own classes except in jumping events.

In all Classes where age of riders is mentioned, it is compulsory that an age certificate for proof of age be requested and upon demand to be shown to the Stewards. If a certificate cannot be produced the competitor shall be automatically disqualified and Barred from the event. The certificate can be in the form of a birth certificate, extract of birth entry, statutory declaration, Baptismal certificate or school certificate.

The Wangaratta Agricultural Society Inc is committed to providing a safe, healthy and environmentally acceptable Showgrounds for all stakeholders.

We shall maintain an effective health and safety program so far as is practicable and endeavor to comply with all statutory and Common Law requirements.

All competitors and exhibitors have a Duty of Care to avoid exposing themselves or other people to unsafe situations that could lead to injury.

All children under the age of 10 years must be supervised by an adult at all times whilst on the showgrounds including the MAIN ARENA.
