2. Racing pigeons must be rung with a ring recognized by a racing pigeon organization.
3. All birds to be penned by 9 am on the day of the show.
4. No bird will be allowed to be removed before 4.30 pm on the day.
5. Any pigeon showing signs of vermin or sickness may be disqualified by the judges.
6. All care will be taken of exhibits while at the show, however, the society will not be responsible for loss or damage.

**Juniors:**

7. Must be over 7 years and under 16 years on the day of the show.

8. Juniors are not permitted to exhibit the same breed as a senior exhibitor living at the same address as the Junior.

9. Juniors should use class numbers provided in this schedule, but please include the letter **J** before the class number.

10. Juniors will compete in the open classes and receive special awards for the Juniors.

Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent.

Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities.

This document is a risk warning for the purpose of the Wrongs Act (1958) VIC.

Any and all warranties, conditions and guarantees in relation to the competitions and activities, Events and use of Suppliers' facilities which are implied by Australian Consumer Law are excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law.
