Exhibitor to provide name of animal and date of birth of each exhibit with entry form.

Exhibitors declare that Exhibits in the Cattle Section are the property of the Exhibitors, and are entered subject to the Rules, Regulations and Conditions of the Society.

All Bulls in this Section D, 12 months old or over, must be rung through the nose and at all times shall be led by such ring. All females to be led with a nose clip.

An animal shall not be admitted to the judging ring during the judging of any class unless it is an exhibit in such class, but a calf of the exhibit in a beef breed class may be admitted if it is under the age of eight months and is being suckled by the exhibit.

All Cattle Must be NLIS Tagged. All Electrical Leads Must be Checked and Tagged before use at the Show.

Waiver: Must be signed and handed back to the show office with entry form.
