- * British Breeds must be visibly tattooed in the ear (F in diamond), together with Breeder's Registered Flock Number.
- * ALL Sheep must be from Brucellosis Accredited Free Flocks, or a Certificate of Blood Test produced on arrival.
- * All sheep are required to have NLIS tags.
- * All Breeders are required to have signed a sheep health statement.

Waiver: Must be signed and handed in to the show office with entry form.

NLIS: All Sheep Must be NLIS Tagged.
