Entry Fees:

Rings 1-2: \$10 per horse block entry (Covers all classes per horse in these rings)

Rings 3-4: \$10 per horse block entry (Covers all classes per horse in these rings)

Ring 3 only: \$5 per class (if not doing a block entry)

Gate Fee - \$20 per vehicle payable with entries, covers all occupants in the vehicle.

Waivers: to be completed online for all competitors.

Stables (booked with entries, limited number so book early):

Lock up boxes \$30

Lock up stalls \$15

Open stalls \$10.

Camping: \$10 per night

Strictly no camping or horses allowed on the ground prior to 5pm Thursday 12th October 2023, all camping & stables must be vacated by the completion of the show at 5pm Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

Regulations:

- **PARKING:** Horses may be tied to floats or trucks in the outside car park.  
*Inside carpark, no horses are to be tied to floats or trucks, you must book a stable or stall or keep your horse on the float.*
- A Competitor must choose to enter in classes as either a Show Hunter or a Show Horse, but not enter both. Once a horse has competed as a Show Horse or a Show Hunter at its first VAS event in a calendar year it must remain as a Show Horse or a Show Hunter at VAS competitions for that calendar year.
- Ring 1 & 2 - Once a horse has successfully won a Champion in its first ring it cannot continue to compete in that equivalent section in other rings during the show. First place getters are eligible to compete in multiple rings until successful as Champion.
- Novice – not to have won a first in this class at any show.
- **GOOD HANDS FOR GIRLS & BOYS - 10 YEARS & UNDER 15 YEARS.**  
*Competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband. A gear check may take place. Please note straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.*
- Exhibitors must be in attendance in the marshalling area to ensure inclusion in event.
- All Dogs must be on a lead & secure, any dogs be found wandering loose will be impounded by the City Pound Keeper.
- At commencement of the Fireworks Display at 8.30 all horses must be securely locked away in stables.
- Exhibitors declare that exhibits in Horse Section are the property of the Exhibitor and are entered subject to the Rules, Regulations and Conditions of the Society.
- Measuring - SHC & EA Certificates will be accepted.
- Stallions are only eligible to compete in their own classes except in jumping events.
- No lunging in the rings.
- In all Classes where age of riders is mentioned, it is compulsory that a proof of age may be requested and upon demand to be shown to the Stewards. If a certificate cannot be produced the competitor shall be automatically disqualified. The certificate can be in the form of a birth certificate, extract of birth entry, statutory declaration, Baptismal certificate or school certificate.
- The Wangaratta Agricultural Society Inc is committed to providing a safe, healthy and environmentally acceptable Showgrounds for all stakeholders. We shall maintain an effective health and safety program so far as is practicable and endeavour to comply with all statutory and Common Law requirements.
- All competitors and exhibitors have a Duty of Care to avoid exposing themselves or other people to unsafe situations that could lead to injury.
- All children under the age of 10 years must be supervised by an adult at all times whilst on the showgrounds including the MAIN ARENA.
