- \* All sheep to be shorn unless otherwise stated; long wools maximum 40 mm, short wools maximum 20 mm.
- \* British Breeds must be visibly tattooed in the ear (F in diamond), together with Breeder's Registered Flock Number.
- \* ALL Sheep must be from Brucellosis Accredited Free Flocks, or a Certificate of Blood Test produced on arrival.
- \* All sheep are required to have NLIS tags.
- \* All Breeders are required to have signed a sheep health statement.

**Waiver:** Must be signed and handed in to the show office with entry form. **NLIS:** *All Sheep Must be NLIS Tagged.*

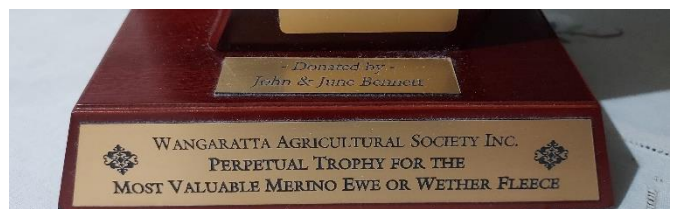
